Obtain a photograph of your bike parked at the city or town limit sign with your license plate and the name of the town clearly visible. You in the picture doesn't hurt either!

Send this application with the \$5.00 fee (per pin), along with the 21 photos to the GLRC Secretary/Treasurer. When they're received, your pin will be sent to you. The towns and cities can be located in ANY of the states or province comprising the GLRC (Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Michigan, Wisconsin, New York, and Ontario).

The catch: NO DUPLICATES can be used for the double letters (IE: L,E,A, and T). So break out that road atlas and hit the highway. Here's your chance to increase your pin collection and earn the bragging rights that come with being a GLRC Traveller. And in the course of your travels if you spot a cop, tell him about the club; he may just end up becoming a member.
