<u>Blast From The Past</u>

(Excerpts from the Chapter VI archives)

August, 1979: Riding rules;

With credit to Ontario-II

- 1. The leader is always right.
- 2. When the leader is wrong, refer to rule #1.
- 3. No cussing (except when obeying rule #2).
- 4. Always keep the rider to your rear in sight.
- 5. When you are lost, refer to rule #3 and #4. (Actually getting lost is prohibited.)
- 6. No obscene gestures to other motorists.

- 8. All breakdowns are forbidden.
- 9. In case of flat tire, electrical short or other catastrophic disaster, refer to rules #3, #6, and #8.
