The 2013 September meeting was held on September 17th, at Alioto's Restaurant.

NEW BUSINESS:

Packer/Bears games: The first game will be Monday Nov. 04th 2013 hosted by Illinois X. The festivities will be at Jesters in Waukegan, IL. International and GLRC issues:

Not a lot to report, the highlights are the upcoming locations of the next GLRC's.

Spring 2014 GLRC will be in Erie Pennsylvania, 3-14-14 to 3-16-14.

Summer 2014 GLRC will be in Galesburg, Ill. This is there ten year anniversary and they want to make this special!! Dates of 8-22-14 to 8-24-14: The events will be at the Knoxville camp grounds. \$20/camper, \$10/tent with lots of kids activities a shuttle bus from hotel, large pool and waterpark...more details to come.

International meeting updates:

-Proposal 2013-0024: request to have the international pay air fare for the founding fathers to attend the 2014 International. Tabled due to costs not being provided.

-Proposal 2013-0025: change the bylaws in section 5.03 regarding the terms of an officer. This motion failed.

-Proposal 2013-0026: Change bylaws Article VII, section 7.02 regarding International collecting the conference's dues. Failed.

-Proposal 2013-0008: Prior motion regarding outsourcing was withdrawn.

-At this time the audit committee is working on getting bids regarding the International books.

-Chappie Rich Bartley has been appointed as International Chaplin, Committee Chair. Questions taken on any of the International updates from the floor? None.

Last thing on the International level: President Kindt donated \$50 (from the chapter) to the family of Jim Foley, the IL XI President who died on the first day of the International.

NEW BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR:

Brian Bortmess spoke on a badge design he and Michael Mihalovits have been putting together. Badges could be done at approximately \$140 per badge.
